## I can say 1 more than a given number up to 10 .

By the end of this half term, children should be able to say one more than any number up to 10.

| 1 more than... | They might be able to record it as a calculation: $\begin{gathered} 0+1=1 \\ 1+1=2 \\ 2+1=3 \\ 3+1=4 \\ 4+1=5 \\ 5+1=6 \\ 6+1=7 \\ 7+1=8 \\ 8+1=9 \\ 9+1=10 \\ 10+1=11 \end{gathered}$ |

Use a number line to hop along one more:

The aim is for them to $\begin{array}{llllllllll}0 & 1 & 2 & 3 & 4 & 5 & 6 & 7 & 8 & 9 \\ 0 & \ddots & \bullet & 0 & 0 & 0 & 0 & 0 & 1\end{array}$
They may be able to say what would be one less too.

## Top Tips

The secret to success is practising little and often. Practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey for example.
